## METHODOLOGY

### *Which companies are included?*

A company is considered a Georgia public company if its principal executive office is located in the State of Georgia and it has equity securities registered under Section 12(b), 12(g) or 15(d) of the Securities Act of 1933 and are listed on an exchange or otherwise publicly traded. A company is included in our survey until termination of registration with the Securities and Exchange Commission, is otherwise clear that the company is no longer operating, or the company has not filed reports with the SEC in the last three years. All data is as of the data cutoff of August 19, 2016. A list of companies in the 2016 study is included later in this document.

### *What is the source of the data?*

The 2016 study data is derived from each company's most recent Annual Report on Form 10-K and Proxy Statement, as filed with the Securities and Exchange Commission by the data cutoff date. Changes that occur after a company files its Form 10-K and Proxy Statement are captured through available 8-K reports until the cutoff date. Every reasonable effort is made to ensure the accuracy of the information included in the survey; however, OnBoard cannot guarantee that the data is entirely without errors.

### *Definition of "Women of Color"*

Within the survey, the designation "women of color" includes women of African, American Indian, Alaska Native, Asian, Hispanic, Latina, or Pacific Island heritage. Because information on the ethnic composition of board members is not publicly available (because not required by securities regulations) the data is presented only in summary form. The data presented here was gathered from publicly available resources, through OnBoard contacts who know the women or directly from companies who voluntarily chose to provide the relevant information.

### *Definition of Executive Officers*

Executive officers for the purposes of the study are only those listed by the companies in their SEC filings, which includes but may not be exclusive to the "Named Executive Officers".

## FACTS AT A GLANCE

- ✓ 60% of Georgia's 125 public companies have one or more women on their boards of directors.
- ✓ Women hold 12.9% (123) of the 952 total board seats in Georgia's public companies, as compared to 12.1% in 2015, 11.2% in 2014, 11.5% in 2013, 10.4% in 2012, and 9.6% in 2011. The number of women held board seats is the highest in the study's history at 123.
- ✓ 16 Georgia public companies have the revenue to be in the ranks of the Fortune 500, and all have at least one women director. Eleven have more than one woman director. In this group, women hold almost 19% of the total director positions, similar to 2014 and 2015.
- ✓ Critical mass for diversity is considered at least 3 women comprising 25% or more of a company's board. In the 2016 study the companies meeting this critical mass definition at the time of the data cutoff are\*: Popeyes Louisiana Kitchen (4), Genuine Parts (4), The Coca-Cola Company (4), Carter's, EarthLink Holdings, Gray Television, Halyard Health, Haverty Furniture Companies, Primerica, The Home Depot and UPS®. \*(Three women unless otherwise noted.) The Southern Company also has 3 women but 20% of the board.
- ✓ 88% of the Georgia Top 50 Companies (ranked by revenue) have women on their boards. Of the 494 director seats in the Georgia Top 50, women hold 81 or 16.4%, up from 16% in 2015, 15% in 2014, 14.4% in 2013, 13.3% in 2012, and 12.4% in 2011.
- ✓ 15 (or 12%) of Georgia Public Companies have women of color on their boards as compared to 12.5 % in 2015, 9.6% in 2014, 12% in 2013, 11.5% in 2012, and 13% in 2011.
- ✓ Women of color hold 2.2% of the 952 board seats in Georgia, the highest percentage since OnBoard started tracking this trend in 2001. Per Catalyst.org (March, 2015), the Fortune 500 U.S. companies have 3.1% women of color board seats.
- ✓ 26% of Georgia's public companies have more than one woman on their board. In the Georgia Top 50, 50% of companies have multiple women board members, while 69% of the Georgia-based Fortune 500 companies have more than one woman director.
- ✓ 111 different women hold current board seats in Georgia Public Companies. Of those, ten women sit on two Georgia boards and one sits on three GPCs. Some of the women are also on the boards of non-Georgia based companies.
- ✓ 16 women directors of Georgia's public companies are inside directors – member of top management, a relative of top management or a significant shareholder.
- ✓ Women hold 12.1% (83) of the 688 executive officer positions listed in the SEC filings, similar to 12.4% in 2015. Since 1998 when OnBoard began counting the executive officers listed in the SEC filings, this percentage had ranged from 7% to 10.5% until 2015. Fifty-six companies list women in this executive officer group.
- ✓ For the 115 companies in both the 2015 and 2016 studies, 91 board seats were filled. Almost 20% were filled with women up from 11.5% in 2015, and 11.9% in 2014 but similar to the period 2010 to 2013 where results ranged from 15% to 21%. The number of seats filled with a woman has never exceeded 13 in a year until this year with 18.

### Work Still to be Done

- ✓ Men hold 87% of the board seats.
- ✓ There are 50 (40%) Georgia public companies that have no women on board.
- ✓ Only 12% of the executive officers as listed in the Georgia companies' SEC filings are women.
- ✓ Women of color in Georgia lag the national stats for percentage of board seats.

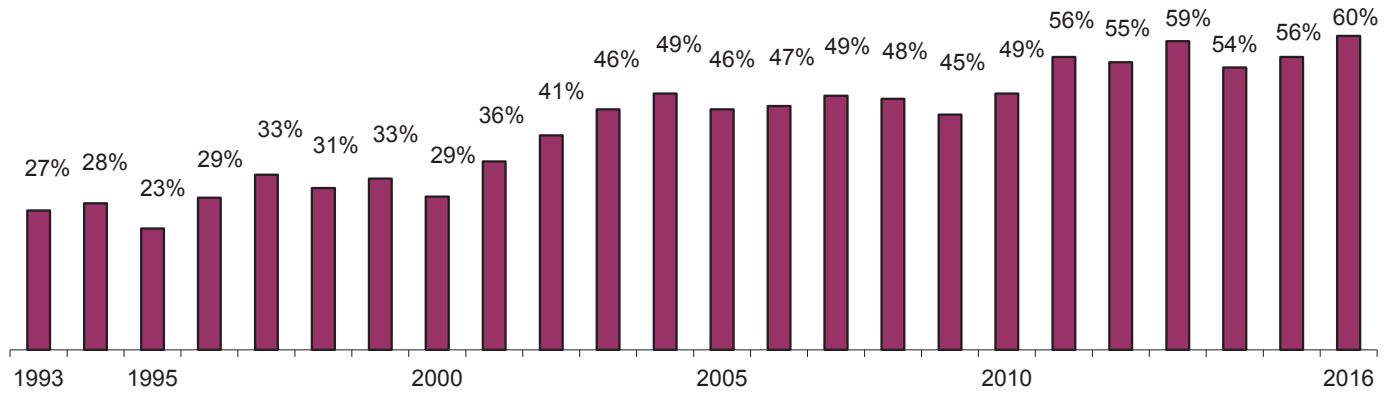

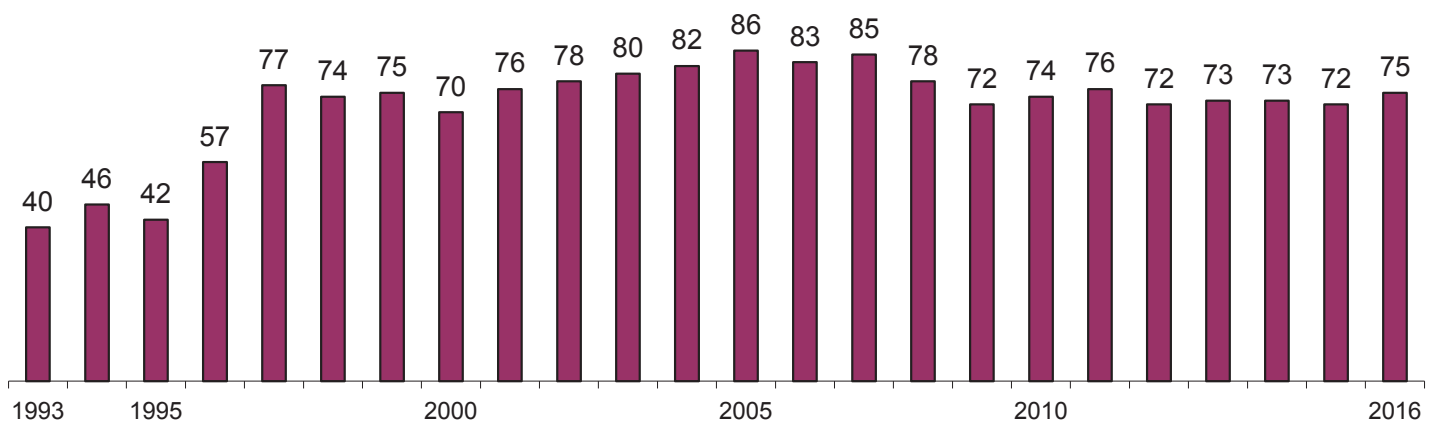

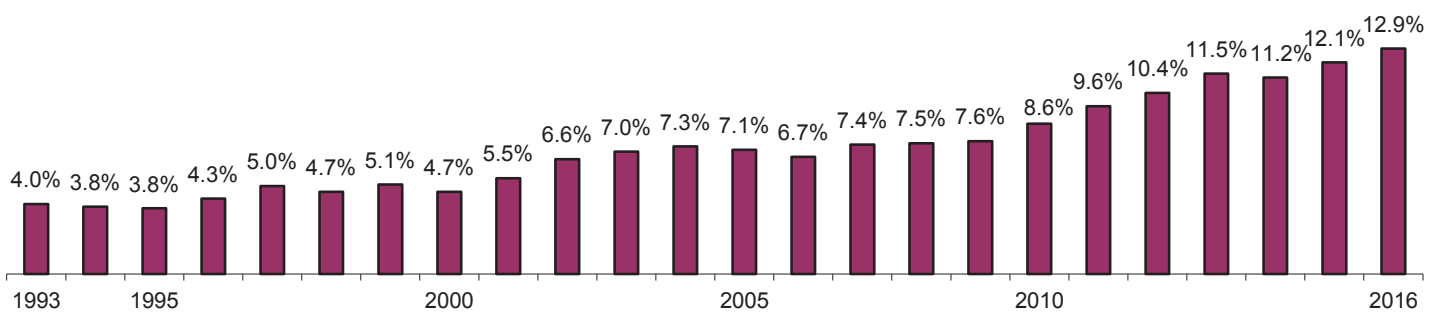
## Percentage of Companies with Women Directors



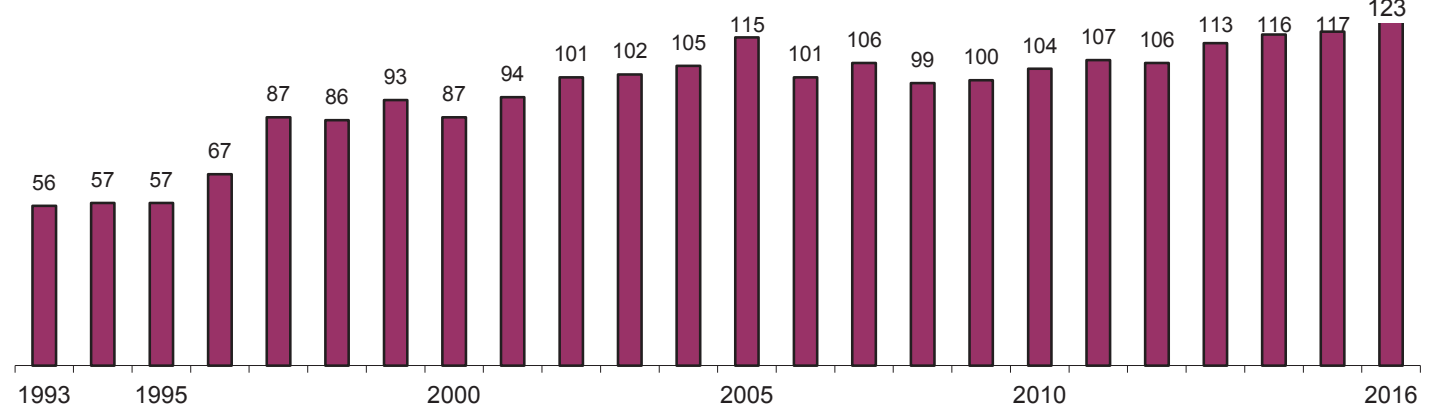
## Number of Companies with Women Directors



## Percentage of Women Held Board Seats



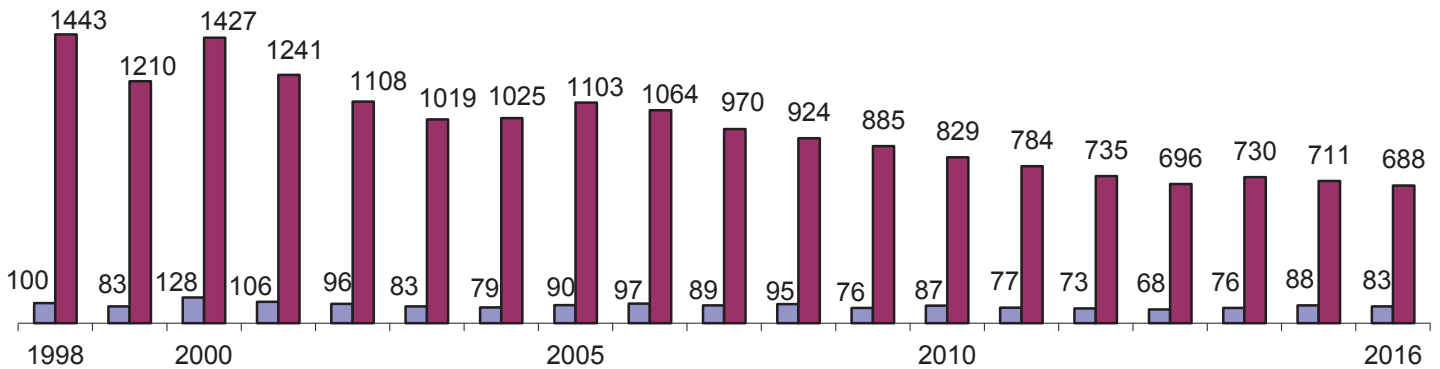

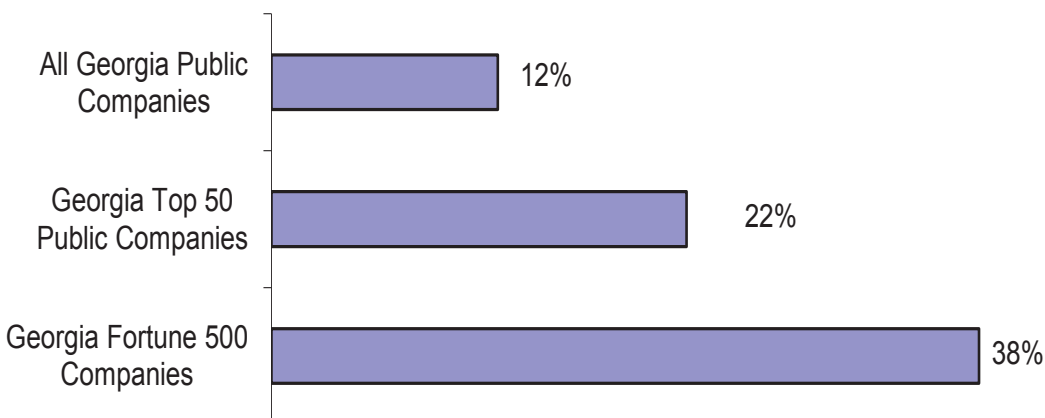
