Rona Wells is President of Wells Holdings, created after retiring from Kimberly-Clark, as a holding company for her angel investments and as a provider of operations management and services for selected individuals, entrepreneurs and organizations. Her board service includes: board of advisors for HolaDoctor, a Spanish-language health and wellness digital network; board of Bank of North Georgia when it was a \$3.7 billion in assets, individually chartered bank, owned by Synovus; and the nonprofit board of Atlanta Chapter of the National Association of Corporate Directors (NACD). Through Wells Holdings, she serves as Executive Director and member of the board of OnBoard.
