OnBoard Accelerator Program

The OnBoard Accelerator program gets women closer to their goal of serving on a for-profit board. With a focus on raising your visibility as a board candidate, we help you develop the tools ensuring that you clearly articulate the value you bring to the board room.

Criteria:

Consideration is open to women with significant responsibility for an operation or function - P&L responsibility is highly desirable (\$500 million or over); C-Suite or substantial division/operating or partnership experience; experience "in the boardroom" as an executive or advisor. Additionally, applicants will be interviewed to assess: their understanding of the responsibilities and liabilities of a director; personal and behavioral attributes in areas such as: thinking; decision-making; ability to communicate effectively; ability to influence; ability to work effectively with other directors as well as senior management; capacity to skillfully represent the organization with stakeholders. The program starts each year in March and meets six times in the program year. Participants must be able to attend meetings and workshops in Atlanta, Georgia, to benefit fully in normal times. With the current circumstances, the sessions are virtual.

Applications will be reviewed, an interview scheduled and invitations to join will be based on the assessment of the applicant's background and readiness to serve on a for profit board.

Fee:

\$2450 - which includes all sessions and workshops for this program payable only after acceptance. OnBoard Advocate level membership is also included in this fee. If you are already an OnBoard Advocate, the fee is \$2150. The nonrefundable fee is payable within 10 business days of upon notification of acceptance or before the first session if sooner.

Instructions:

1. Please review the attached criteria before completing the application in order to describe your credentials, experience and skills as thoroughly as possible.
2. In addition to the application, a resume and an organizational chart are required.

4. Once the application is reviewed, you will be contacted for an interview.

5. Deadline for the class is one month prior to start of the first class, but since the 10 seats in the class will be filled as applications are submitted and approved, early submission is encouraged.

7. Describe the outcomes you expect from participation in the program.

8. Please provide any other information which you believe makes you a candidate for board service.
